Escalatory Steps of Greece between 12 September and 20 October 2020 (Updated Version)




Immediately following the return of Oruç Reis, Greece deployed naval units to the island of Kastellorizo on 13 September 2020.


Various naval assets continue being stationed in Kastellorizo since then in violation of its demilitarized status.





